

## THE ST ANDREW'S - CAPERNWRAY BIBLE SCHOOLS SCHOLARSHIP

St Andrew's Church has been blessed with young people who are excited by their faith in Jesus Christ, many of whom long for the opportunity to further their education in a recognized Bible school program. Through the generosity of an individual and beginning in 1998 for as long as the Donor is able to provide, two scholarships, each of \$2,500, will be awarded each year through St Andrew's Presbyterian Church, Duncan, to assist two young people from this congregation in yearlong studies at an international Capernwray Torchbearers Bible School.

### Terms

The scholarship will be paid by St Andrew's Church directly to the Capernwray School of choice, in two instalments, one per term, upon written notice of acceptance by the school. Under special circumstances, enrolment may be deferred for one year. Students may apply for the Scholarship to attend other Bible schools offering an equivalent program, but preference will be given to Capernwray schools. Similarly, students may request to study in continental North America, but the Donor's intent is to encourage and facilitate international experience.

The awarding committee also reserves the option of:

- a) awarding one candidate a double scholarship (\$5,000) where circumstances warrant, or
- b) reserving one or both scholarships in any given year where there are either no applicants or appropriate candidates. The reserved scholarship(s) could be awarded the following year. Scholarship funds will not be carried over beyond one year.

### Eligibility and Application Procedure

Successful candidates for the St Andrew's - Capernwray Scholarship will be active participants in the life of St Andrew's Presbyterian Church, Duncan. They shall exemplify Christian commitment and demonstrate a desire to grow in their walk with the Lord. Preference will be given to recent graduates from high school, but applications from mature students will also be considered.

Applicants must fill out the attached form completely and submit it to the church office, along with all supporting documents requested, by May 1st of the current year, along with a copy of the written acceptance (or evidence of application pending) from the school to which the scholarship will be applied.

Recipients of the scholarship are encouraged to write two letters of appreciation to the Donor, care of St Andrew's Church – the first at the time the award is announced, and the second, upon completion of their studies. Recipients are also expected to report to the congregation through an article in the church newsletter concerning their year of studies and experiences.

### The Selection Committee

The Session of St Andrew's Church will annually appoint a Selection Committee to review the applications and, if considered helpful, to conduct interviews with the candidates. The Committee will normally be composed of two elders plus one staff member and/or member of the congregation.

- d) Describe your most rewarding experiences of volunteer service.
- e) Comment on your personal strengths and weaknesses. In what areas of ministry in the life of the church do you sense God leading or equipping you?
- f) Why do you wish to attend Bible College? How do you hope this experience will have an impact on your future goals?

#### 4) **Documentation**

Please submit the application form, your answers to the above questions, along with a letter of acceptance from the Capernwray School of your choice (or evidence of application pending), and the letters of reference. The Committee also requests a financial summary of your anticipated expenses and available resources for this year of study. All documentation should be submitted by May 1 to:
