

THE ROY AND LEONTINE HEYD MEMORIAL BURSARY

Roy and Leontine Heyd were strong supporters of post-secondary education and of Christian education and missions. In their memory, and through the generosity of their families, George and Ruth Heyd, and Maria and Larry Smith, an annual bursary will be made available to assist those who wish to participate in short-term Christian education and missions. Preferences for this bursary are as follows:

- 1) because of the generous donation of the Capernwray Scholarships, preference will be given to individuals wishing to participate in a different short-term course of studies and mission outreach, such as the DTS program offered by Mercy Ships and YWAM;
- 2) preference is for the bursary to be awarded to a student graduating from secondary school, but applications will be considered from other youth and from adults;
- 3) if there is no bursary awarded for a particular year, the money will become part of the investment principal. To make up for this, in the following year(s), more than one bursary winner may be chosen, at the discretion of the bursary committee;
- 4) except in unusual circumstances, the bursary is to be used within twelve months of being awarded.

Eligibility and Application Procedure

Successful candidates for the Heyd Bursary will have been involved in the life of St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church, Duncan. They will show an openness and honesty toward learning more about Christianity and how to share Christ with others.

Applicants must fill out the attached form completely and submit it to the church office, along with all supporting documents requested, by May 1st of the current year, along with proof of acceptance (or evidence of application pending) from the school to which the scholarship will be applied.

Recipients of the scholarship are encouraged to write letters of thanks to the Donors care of St. Andrew's church, and to write to the congregation through an article in the church newsletter describing their experiences in their studies and mission outreach.

The Selection Committee

The Session of St. Andrew's Church will annually appoint a Selection Committee to review the applications, and, if considered helpful, to conduct interviews with the candidates. The Committee will normally be composed of two elders plus one staff member and/or member of the congregation.

- c) How long have you been involved with St. Andrew's Church? In what way(s)?

- d) Is your family supportive of your desire to participate in your studies/mission? In what way(s)?
- e) Why do you want to participate in your chosen studies and mission outreach?
