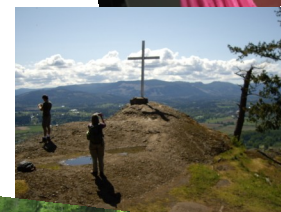
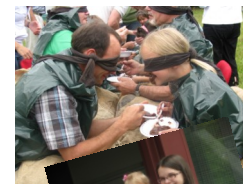

Ministries

Pastoral Care/Health Ministry—

Believing all healing & hope flows ultimately from Jesus, our care and recovery ministries address people's spiritual, emotional and physical needs

- **Prayer/Personal Growth—** concerns are upheld in prayer by a group of intercessors who believe in the power of prayer.
- **Pastoral Counseling—** individual, marital and family counseling is important and available for people at all ages and stages of life. A person-oriented, Christ-centered, pastoral approach is offered to persons within the church and beyond
- **Recovery—**we offer programs that address many different areas faced in life from finances to grief, to care for children and adults, in the midst of separation and divorce
- **Pastoral Care—**we offer a variety of care programs to meet the many needs of the church: Loaves & Fishes, Meals for Moms, Prayer Shawl Ministry

Children & Youth— Programming is designed to meet the needs of our children where they are at

- **Youth Group—**Friday nights (gr. 7-12) Teens enjoy a wide variety of social activities, recreation, and meaningful discussions.
- **Sunday School** where learning about Jesus is fun and alive
- **Nursery—**supervised care is provided during the 2nd service for children ages birth to 2 years

Adults—St. Andrew's has a strong commitment to helping adults of all ages grow spiritually

- **House Churches** and Bible Study Groups—groups of 5-15 participants meet for study of the Bible, prayer, and caring for one another
- **Men's Ministries—**focus is on fellowship, sharing, discussion, support and outreach. Men's Breakfast, Men's Fellowship Group
- **Women's Ministries—**focus is on fellowship, sharing, discussion, support and outreach. Ladies Guild, Ladies Bible Studies, Retreats
- **Nifty Fifty Plus—**an opportunity is provided for those 55 yrs plus to come together for fellowship. Good food, friendly conversation and a short program are often on the agenda

Music Ministries

Our Music Ministries strive to help the congregation in a full expression of worship, while ministering to one another in an atmosphere of mutual care and support—Praise Team and Special Music opportunities form a part of this vibrant ministry

- **Redemption Gardens—** provides nearly 50 raised beds for church goers and the community surrounding us
