

THE MICHELLE YANO MEMORIAL FUND

Mandate

The Michelle Yano Memorial Fund is established to provide an annual gift of money which may enable a young person(s) from the congregation to participate in outreach and mission projects, either local or abroad, being undertaken by the youth of St. Andrew's Church.

Terms

1. The fund will be managed by the Session through its Bursary Committee, with the capital invested according to the advice of the committee and as approved by Session. Annual interest income from the fund should normally be divided, with approximately 25% added to the capital and the remaining 75% made available for project grants. The fund will be audited annually and reported in the annual reports to the congregation. The capital may be added to at any time by additional gifts.
2. Gifts awarded from the Yano bursary shall be recommended to the Session for approval by the Youth Pastor or by the Minister. Such awards must clearly be part of an approved outreach or mission project being undertaken by the youth of St. Andrew's Church.
3. All gifts or projects funded by the Michelle Yano Memorial Fund are to be publicized for the information of the congregation through the Dove and the annual reports.
4. Recipients of the Fund are required to write a letter of thanks to the Yano family, care of the Session, in which they will report on their experience in the mission or outreach project.
